Contest Requirements: Develop a work of art to symbolize and promote **National Black HIV/AIDS Awareness Day (NBHAAD)**, February 7, 2008. **NBHAAD** is a national mobilization effort designed to encourage African Americans across the United States and Territorial Areas to **get educated, get tested, get treated** and **get involved** with HIV/AIDS, as it continues to devastate Black communities. The art should feature messages that promote **National Black HIV/AIDS Awareness Day** objectives. Messages should be directed to African Americans of any age group ranging from youth to seniors.

Entry Criteria: Contest is open to all students at [name of school(s)/institution(s)].

Media: Black and white or full-color original art works in one of the following media – illustration, photography, fine art painting, mixed media.

Dimensions: Entries must be formatted to no larger than 36" x 24".

Entry Deadline: Entries must be completed no later than 5:00 p.m. on January 23, 2008. Entries will be judged at [name of school(s)/institution(s)] on [Date]. Winners will be announced on [Date].

Awards: First, second, and third place entries will receive [TBD]. The top 10 entries will be featured in a **National Black HIV/AIDS Awareness Day** showcase and on the website on February 7, 2008.
